

What Will Measure A Fund at Archie?

Measure A will provide significant upgrades at all five of the Tam District High Schools with the goal of having equal facilities at each school after the upgrades have been completed, so that all students have equivalent spaces in which to learn and grow.

Measure A Included an Extensive Master Planning Process

The facilities master planning process took almost two years to complete and included extensive feedback from teachers and staff, which in addition to the necessary repairs that were identified by the architectural and construction professionals, were used to develop the project list that Measure A will fund. At Archie, Measure A funds will cover all of the work that was identified as being necessary for the next 15 plus years.

Archie has some significant advantages from a construction perspective that make the work at our school less expensive than the other sites, including being single story, serving the fewest students, and being built on bedrock flat ground. Luckily, unlike Redwood, Tam, and Tamiscal, Archie doesn't have any classrooms that, by state law, have to be torn down and replaced instead of remodeled.



Measure A Will:

- Replace leaking roofs, outdated HVAC irrigation, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing infrastructure
- Upgrade the theater
- Repair labs
- Demolish unusable portable classrooms
- Add outdoor learning environments

- Add shade structures
- Improve disability access
- Expand student services/wellness space
- Upgrade bathrooms, the fieldhouse, and athletic fields
- Add air conditioning

Ongoing Upgrades and Upgrades from Past Bonds

- Complete remodel of the interiors of the school, inclusive of new floors, ceilings, walls, cabinets, teaching walls, and classroom infrastructure
- New pool
- New six-plex building
- Adding solar
- Upgrades to Red Hill
- New cafeteria and student services space
